Welcome to the second newsletter of the summer. Exciting things are happening on the Hill as we prepare for Leadership Camp, Early Week, and the start of the coming school year!

First, we are happy to announce the appointment of Chase Jones as Interim Assistant Director of Bands. A native of Ashdown, AR, Mr. Jones brings extensive teaching experience in concert bands and athletic bands to our program. He received the Bachelor of Music Education degree and Master of Music in Instrumental Conducting from the University of Arkansas. Mr. Jones was drum major of the Razorback Marching Band from 2009-2011 and as a graduate teaching assistant in the band program from 2013-2015 he designed halftime shows for the RMB, conducted each of the five concert bands, and directed the Hogwild Pep Band. Mr. Jones has been Director of Bands and led the 225-member Sebastian River High School Bands in Sebastian, FL for the last seven years. Under his direction the Sebastian River Marching Band was a finalist at the 2021 Orlando Bands of America regional and the Sebastian River Wind Ensemble recently

received superior ratings at the Florida State Concert Band Assessment. Mr. Jones was a drum major of the Phantom Regiment Drum and Bugle Corps in 2009.

We are anticipating record enrollment at the University of Arkansas and in the Razorback Marching Band this fall, and we are looking forward to your arrival on campus!

Leadership Camp - August 5-7

RMB Placement Auditions

For all winds, initial placement in the pregame and halftime drills will be based on your playing audition for chair placement and marching audition.

- The playing audition will be on Monday, August 15th.
- The marching audition component will be taught during the first two days of Early Week, and auditions will also take place on Monday, August 15th.

Audition materials will be available on Tuesday, July 5th in the "Band Members Only" section of bands.uark.edu. Enter your university email user name and password to access this section. Files are in PDF format, organized by instrument under the heading "Fall 2022 RMB Chair Placement Excerpts." The fight song excerpt must be MEMORIZED. You may use the music for the other excerpts. 
