

Requirements for a Second Major in Middle East Studies

Students may elect a combined major in Middle East Studies together with a departmental major in anthropology, communication, economics, French, geography, history, international studies, journalism, political science, sociology, or Spanish. New students entering the program are required to notify the director or studies or their intention to participate.

LANGUAGE (total hours vary):

- ARAB 3016** Intensive Arabic III or six hours of ARAB language courses numbered 3000 or higher.

REQUIRED COURSES (6 hours):

- MEST 2013** Intro to Middle East Studies
- MEST 4003** Middle East Studies Colloquium

ELECTIVES (18 hours):

At least **eighteen** hours in additional MEST-approved courses. Courses must come from at least **two** departments, with at least **nine** hours in one department.
