

The African and African American Studies (AAS) program promotes an interdisciplinary approach to the study of the history, culture, and identity of Africans and African Americans. Students may pursue African and African American Studies as a **second major** alongside a primary major in Fulbright College. Students in other colleges may declare a minor. Advice on suitable primary majors to be taken with an AAS second major may be obtained from the AAS Program Director.
