

Remote Delivery vs Online vs In-Person

This guide will hopefully help you determine how a class will be delivered.



Question: The course is 100% online, can I take it?

Answer: Yes and No. Some online courses are reserved for on-campus majors and some for online-only majors. You cannot register for sections reserved for online-only majors. Check the section number for a quick reference. Odd section numbers (901, 903, etc.) are for on-campus majors. Even section numbers (902, 904, etc.) are for online-only majors. There are no overrides for online-only major sections. You can also find this information in the class notes.



Remote Delivery vs Online vs In-Person

The process of moving courses to remote delivery is on-going, so what you see today may change. You should receive an email for any changes to your courses, but it is also good to check your schedule from time to time.

Question:

How do remote delivery hours affect my online hours total?

Answer:

Each student is allowed to complete up to 35% of that courses taken at the U of A as online. Remote Delivery courses <u>do not</u> count toward this total.
