

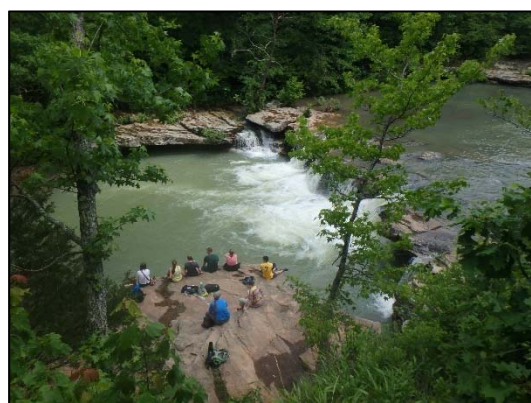
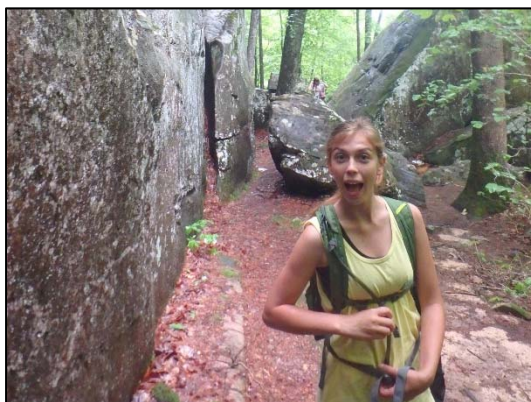
Research Experience for Undergraduates (REU)
