In the interest of accountability for polls and pollsters, we try to catalog the Arkansas Poll's track record. While it is not our primary aim to be in the election prediction business, the ArkPoll team has tested – directly or indirectly – 40 statewide elections; we've blown five.

A pattern emerges in the table presented below: generally, the lower the profile the item (i.e., the lower its "salience") and/or the more buried the details in the ballot title, the more likely we are to be wrong/off by a wide margin. A good (well, bad) example is Initiated Act 1 of 2008. The explanation for that flip is multi-parted but, chiefly, the measure's opponents effectively made it a referendum on gays and lesbians whereas we used the referendum's actual language: "cohabitating couples."
