

German MA Checklist of Application Materials

Be sure to **apply for the MA program** through the [Graduate School website](#)

If applying for a Teaching Assistantship in German, please submit the following items to the graduate advisor:

- A statement of purpose (1-2 pages)
- The TA application, which is found on the WLLC site
- An audio recording (digital file) of a passage read in German and impromptu speaking **
- A writing sample written in German (2-3 pages) **
- Information for three (3) recommenders **
(online; Letters of Recommendation are submitted as part of the Graduate School application)

For MA candidates who are **not applying** for a Teaching Assistantship, the following documents should be sent to the graduate advisor:

- A statement of purpose (1-2 pages)
- A writing sample of an essay written in German (2-3 pages)

**For University of Arkansas graduates of our BA program in German, you are not required to submit letters of recommendation, the audio recording, or the writing sample, but may be asked to do so at the discretion of the Graduate Advisor.
